

STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only) This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	£2,870
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£1055
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care	£275
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at our funeral director's branch premises:	£265
Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from foil veneered mahogany	£505
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer)	£45
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle	£725

UNATTENDED FUNERAL

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

Collection and delivery of ashes

For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the **burial fee**.¹
In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is:
£488.50 - £749

For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.

For an Attended cremation funeral, the **cremation fee**. £951.30 - £985

The date and time of the funeral will be at our discretion. Arrangements must take place on our premises.

A Hearse and four bearers will be provided for the attended and unattended funeral.
